## VERIFICATION AND EVALUATION METHODS OF THE LEARNING OUTCOMES ACHIEVED BY THE STUDENT DURING THE WHOLE LEARNING CYCLE:

The teacher conducting classes defines learning outcomes and the form of their verification, and then places them in the course syllabus. Achieving all learning outcomes specified for individual classes means the implementation of the assumed concept of education in the field of study. Verification and assessment of the learning outcomes achieved by the student throughout the entire education cycle takes place through:

- 1) evaluating student's preparation for classes, participation during classes;
- 2) coursework (final tests, tests, reports, presentations, projects);
- 3) exams (oral, written exam, etc.);
- 4) **student internship** (in accordance with the internship programme);
- 5) **process of certification** (in accordance with the study regulations).
